AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF HADDONFIELD IN THE COUNTY OF CAMDEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY TO AMEND CHAPTER 114 ENTITLED FIRE REVENTION

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Borough of Haddonfield in the County of Camden, State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION I

1. Chapter 114, entitled Fire Prevention, is hereby amended by the deletion of § 114-8(B)(2) in its entirety and replaced with the following:

§ 114-8(B)(2) Fees and waivers

- A. The fee for this inspection shall be \$35, made payable to the Borough of Haddonfield, if the application is submitted and paid more than five business days prior to settlement. The fee shall be \$75 if application is made less than five (5) business days in advance. If the property does not comply with the requirements, one re-inspection will be made at no additional charge. However, additional re-inspection will require a prepaid fee of \$25 for reach re-inspection.
- B. A waiver of this fee and inspection will only be authorized for the sale of a newly constructed home within sixty (60) days of the issuance of a Certificate of Occupancy by the Construction Official.

SECTION II

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this amending ordinance be and they are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies only.

SECTION III

If any section or provision of this ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid by any court, the remaining sections and provisions shall, notwithstanding such holding, remain and be in full force and effect.


SECTION IV
