

## ***2010 Tanner Street Utility Replacement Project***

### ***Project Update No. 3***

*October 4, 2010*

Unfortunately the weather did not cooperate during the past week and PACT Construction was only able to work on Tuesday and Wednesday. During the weather shortened week, the contractor was able to complete the testing of the new water main and install nine (9) new water services. They also excavated “test pits” at the intersection of Euclid Avenue and Haddon Avenue. The results of the test pits, which were installed to confirm the location and depth of the existing gas main in the intersection, indicated that there were no major conflicts between the proposed new water main and the existing gas main in this area of the project.
