

# 2009 Road Program Summary

## Haddonfield Borough, NJ

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### **FY 2007 NJDOT Safe Routes to School - Chestnut Street Roadway Reconstruction Project – Phase II**

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The project consists of the reconstruction of Chestnut Street from Lincoln Avenue to East Park Avenue and it completes the work started last year on the section of Chestnut Street from East Park Avenue to Reillywood Avenue. The project will consist of the installation of a concrete raised intersection, with clay brick pavers at the intersection of Chestnut Street and Lincoln Avenue. This traffic calming measure, which completes the proposed traffic calming work on Lincoln Avenue, will require the installation of a new storm sewer pipe that will run from East Atlantic Avenue along East Park Avenue to Chestnut Street and then to the new raised intersection at Lincoln Avenue. Also included in the project will be the replacement of older sanitary sewer house laterals and individual water services and the replacement of existing concrete curbing and driveway aprons, the resetting of existing slate curbing and brick sidewalks, and the complete reconstruction of the asphalt pavement in the project area.

Each homeowner in the project area is reminded they are still responsible for the water service and sewer lateral from their house to the newly installed house shut-off and cleanout; however, a construction project such as this one is always a good time to consider having your plumber (or other qualified contractor) replace the remaining older piping.
