

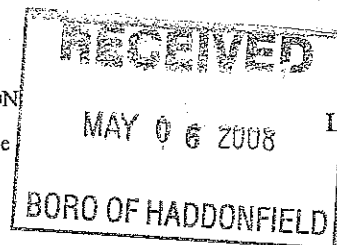


Thank you for submitting an Application for Project Authorization pursuant to the New Jersey Register of Historic Places Act (NJRHPA) for the above referenced project pursuant to the New Jersey Register of Historic Places Act of 1970 as amended (N.J.S.A. 13:1B-15.131 as implemented by N.J.A.C. 7:4-7.1). HPO staff determined that the Application for Project Authorization was technically and professionally complete and sufficient pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:4-7.1(d), on April 30, 2008.

Based on the submitted project documentation, the HPO has determined that the project as proposed and documented will **not constitute an encroachment on the Haddonfield Historic District** for the following reasons:

1. All work outlined in the Application is in conformance with the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties.
2. The proposed project will not destroy the materials, features, and spatial relationships that characterize the historic district and new work will be compatible with the historic materials, features, and setting of the historic district and its environment.

The Reconstruction of Chestnut Street and Traffic Calming project is in compliance with Project Authorization Review of the NJRHPA and may proceed as documented unless there is an unexpected discovery during project construction, or a change in the project's scope of work.
