

**Authorization to Award Bid –
FY2007 Federal Aid Safe Routes to School –
Chestnut Street and Lincoln Avenue Traffic Calming Project**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Borough of Haddonfield, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. That Jads Construction, P.O. Box 513, South River, New Jersey 08882 is hereby determined to be the lowest qualified bidder in connection with the receipt of Sealed Bids on Tuesday, June 30, 2009 for the FY2007 Federal Aid Safe Routes to School – Chestnut Street and Lincoln Avenue Traffic Calming Project for the Borough of Haddonfield.
2. That the Chief Financial Officer of the Borough has certified that the funds will be legally available as follows: \$200,000 from G-02-40-727-000-000 (Safe Routes to School Grant); \$278,541.75 from C-04-55-927-000-001 (2009 Road Program).
3. That the proper officer or officers of the Borough of Haddonfield be, and they are authorized and directed for and in the name of said Borough to sign the grant agreement and any and all other documents relating to this matter.
