

*HMHS Stadium & Anniversary Fields Improvements
Project Update No. 1
June 17, 2013*

Work Completed Since the Start of the Project on 5/28/13:

Construction began on Anniversary Field with the trimming of trees (by the Borough DPW), installation of soil erosion controls, the scraping and removal of topsoil, and the grading of the field. The stormwater outlet structure was set in the northeast corner, and the connection of the 8-inch diameter overflow pipe was connected to the existing inlet on Hopkins Lane. Sections of the 24-inch underdrain for the field were also installed along Hopkins Lane and the north side of the field.

Anticipated Work for the Weeks of June 17 and 24:

Work will continue on the installation of underdrain pipe and structures on Anniversary Field, along with the start of construction on the perimeter curb for the field. After HMHS graduation ceremonies on 6/20, the Contractor will cross over to begin work on Stadium Field, including stripping topsoil, grading, and pipe installation. In addition, a subcontractor will bore an 8-inch pipe underneath the track to connect the drainage systems between the two fields.
