Tanner Street Roadway Reconstruction Project Project Update No. 1 July 15, 2011

Work Completed Since Start of Construction on July 11, 2011:

The Contractor began work on the project in earnest on Monday, July 11 by completing tree removal at all approved locations, including along Library Point. Curb removal and replacement along the west side of the street was completed from Euclid Avenue to the Quaker Shoe Repair Shop (including re-setting of existing slate curb). Work began on the replacement of various

driveway aprons on the same side, and a few sections of sidewalk were removed and replaced.
