To: Properties abutting Westminster Avenue (Station Ave to Borough limits)

Re: Planned Road Reconstruction Project

In order to complete the work that has been performed in your area, the Borough Commissioners have authorized road reconstruction of Westminster Avenue starting at Station Avenue to the Borough limits and the portion of Marquis Road that was disturbed during the installation of the sump pump collection system. The project will also include installation of new concrete curbing, new concrete driveway aprons, and some sidewalk replacement or installation where necessary based on the judgment of the Borough Engineer.

DiMeglio Construction Co. of Atco, NJ will be the Borough's contractor for the road reconstruction portion. They are expected to begin as early as the week of September 29th. As always, the schedule is based upon good weather. The contractor will notify each homeowner prior to beginning construction. Concrete work is expected to begin the week of October 1st with the road reconstruction scheduled for October 27th.

Roads will be closed to local traffic only during the construction period. During the normal workday, starting after 7:00 a.m., there will be some impact on parking and traffic while the work is being done. On street parking will not be allowed during the workday on the block(s) the contractor is working on. Cars must be off the road by 7:00 a.m. The Police Department is aware of this situation and will relax enforcement of the overnight parking regulations where appropriate. If you have any concern, please call 784-9161 for overnight parking permission. Trash and recycling will continue to be picked up on your normal day. The contractor; however, has requested that all trash and recycling be picked up no later than 7:30 am, which may be earlier than you are accustomed to. Further information will be sent at a later date regarding leaf pickup once we have determined the best course of action. Please do not rake your leaves and place them on the curb if the contractor is working on your block.

We appreciate your patience and understanding throughout the past few months. We are in the final stages of this project. The Engineer will provide an overview of the construction project, process and project updates every two weeks, which will be posted to the Borough website under the road program page located in the Public Works section of the website.
