Expanded Parking Areas with Reclaimed Cobblestones & RR Ties

Work Completed the Week of August 8:

Curb and sidewalk work at the widened parking areas was completed and work continued at the Euclid/Haddon Avenue intersection. Roadway excavation continued full-width of the street, including reclamation of cobblestones from the existing roadway bed to be reused on the site. Excess cobblestones are to be stored at the Public Works yard for future use within the Borough.

Anticipated Work for the Week of August 15:

The Contractor will continue concrete curb and sidewalk work at the Euclid/Haddon Avenue intersection. Excavation of the roadway for reconstruction will also continue down Tanner Street towards Kings Highway. **TRAFFIC NOTE:** Tanner Street will be completely closed during working hours a block at a time for the week. Through traffic will be detoured at Wilkins Avenue or Clement Avenue. Local businesses will have access at all times.
