Dear Resident,

Over the past four months the Borough hired two contractors to perform extensive work on Westminster Ave. This included a new sanitary sewer main, new sewer laterals, new manholes, replacement of ten old galvanized water services, installation of new stormwater piping and inlets, installation of a new sump pump collection system on portions of Westminster and Marquis, new curb, new driveway aprons, a portion of new sidewalks, handicapped ramps and finally a newly paved roadway. In short, the cost of this project was approximately \$621,000. This project provided a significant amount of new infrastructure.

On behalf of the Commissioners I would like to state that we are aware that this has been a long and arduous process. We wanted to express our gratitude for the patience that you have shown while you have endured difficult circumstances. We hope that the long term end result has been worth the short-term trouble construction work always causes.

There may be punch list items which have not been completed at this time. I would urge that if you are aware of any problems created by the various contractors that you reach out to either Steve Fini (795-9596) or Charles Chelotti (795-9595), both of whom are employees of Remington and Vernick, the Borough Engineer firm.
