To: Properties abutting Colonial Avenue (Kings Highway East to Lake Street)
Properties abutting Lake Street (Colonial Avenue to Grove Street)

Re: Planned Road Reconstruction Project

The Borough Commissioners have authorized road reconstruction for both blocks of Colonial Avenue and the one block stretch of Lake Street from Colonial Avenue to Grove Street. The project will also include installation of new concrete curbing, new concrete driveway aprons, and some sidewalk replacement or installation where necessary based on the judgment of the Borough Engineer.

Marandino Concrete Co., Inc. of Vineland, NJ will do the road work. The contractor advised us today that he will begin the job as early as September 23. The residents on Lake Street should have received a notice today from the contractor indicating that he would begin work tomorrow. Work will begin on the south side of Lake Street starting at Grove, working down the one side of the roadway then crossing over to the other side of the block. Once all concrete work has been completed on Lake Street the contractor will begin the concrete work on Colonial Avenue. The roadway will be milled and reconstructed upon completion of all concrete work. This contract is anticipated to be complete within 45 days. As always, the schedule is based upon good weather continuing.

Concrete aprons must cure for three days prior to being driven on. Residents will not be able to access their driveways during this time. You may park in front of your home on the street if you are able to move your car prior to 7:00am or park on one of the adjacent streets.

Roads will be closed to local traffic only during the construction period. During the normal workday, starting after 7:00 a.m., there will be some impact on parking and traffic while the work is being done. On street parking will not be allowed during the workday on the block(s) the contractor is working on. Cars must be off the road by 7:00 a.m. Please contact my office should you have day-time parking issues. The Police Department is aware of this situation and will relax enforcement of the overnight parking regulations where appropriate. If you have any concern, please call 784-9161 for overnight parking permission. Trash and recycling will continue to be picked up on your normal day (Thursday). The contractor; however, has requested

that all trash and recycling be picked up no later than 7:30 am, which may be earlier than you are accustomed to. Further information will be sent at a later date regarding leaf pickup once we have determined the best course of action. Please do not rake your leaves and place them on the curb if the contractor is working on your block.

We appreciate your patience and understanding throughout the past few months. We are in the final stages of this project. The Engineer will provide an overview of the construction project, process and project updates every two weeks, which will be posted to the Borough website under the road program page located in the Capital Projects section of the website.
