Re: Planned Utility and Road Improvement Project

I wanted to take a moment to update you on the status of the utility and road improvement program. The contractor began work on Mount Vernon back in July. They installed a new sanitary sewer main, sewer laterals and water services. This work was completed by mid-August. Utility work then began on Pomona. A new sanitary sewer main and a new water main have been installed at this time. The contractor is in the process of installing the sewer laterals and water services. Once this is finished the utility portion of the project is complete.

On Mount Vernon concrete curb and aprons have been completed on the west side. The contractor is currently working on finishing up the east side. This is the first step in the road improvement project. The contractor will then pulverize the roadway, repair any base paving issues and lay final top coat. It is anticipated that the concrete crews will move over to Pomona starting the week of September 15. The entire project is expected to be complete by the end of September.
