TRASH RULES DOWNTOWN COMMERCIAL AREA

Please review **Chapter 195: Solid Waste** in the code of the Borough of Haddonfield, online at www.haddonfieldnj.org.

These rules are in place to keep the amount of time garbage is left on the curb and never in the road, to a minimum and improve the overall appearance of our neighborhoods. **NOTHING CAN BE PLACED OR RAKED ONTO A PUBLIC ROADWAY.** Containers **MUST** be placed at the curb and or park strip and are **NEVER** permitted in the public roadway.

Business District trash cannot be put out before 5:00PM of the day before collection and cannot be left out over the weekend. Refuse must be out by 7:00AM for residential areas and by 6:30AM for businesses, including residences in the business district, on the scheduled trash day to insure collection.

1. No trash will be collected on Kings Highway from Haddon Ave to the High Speed Line on the east side and from Friends Avenue (excluding Oriental Pearl) to the High Speed Line on the west side.
2. All other locations other than those listed in #1 shall place their trash at the curb in front of their building.
3. Trash should be placed at the appropriate spot marked on the map for your location. These locations are designated for the businesses and tenants located in the buildings marked. Trash should not be brought from outside the Downtown Commercial Area and deposited in these locations.
4. All food waste must be placed in bags and then in trash cans with lids per state statute and Borough Code.
Restaurants must comply with this regulation.
5. All trash must be in trash cans or in heavy duty 1.3 mils thick, black trash bags, and tied. Trash must be placed curbside in metal or plastic cans with lids of no more than 32-gallon capacity or heavy-duty plastic bags of 1.3 mil thickness. Trash will not be picked up in paper bags, cardboard boxes, containers larger than 32 gallons, bushel baskets, metal or plastic tubs.
6. Trash, garbage, or other waste materials must be placed in suitable plastic or metal containers which are covered or otherwise contained in such a way that the waste material cannot escape from the container, attract vermin, emit odor, or cause spilling into stormwater sewer drains and/or the waters of the state in order to protect public health, safety, and welfare.
7. Such persons shall be responsible for immediately removing from any street, sidewalk, or private property any material which leaves, falls, or escapes from the waste container for any reason prior to it being collected, and shall pay any costs for such removal.
8. **TRASH CANNOT BE PLACED OUT BEFORE 5:00 PM SUNDAY THROUGH THURSDAY.**
9. **TRASH IS NOT PICKED UP ON SATURDAY OR SUNDAY AND MUST NOT BE PLACED OUT FOR PICKUP ON FRIDAY OR SATURDAY.**
10. Recycling is a law and must be followed.
11. Trash placed curbside in cardboard boxes (ex. Styrofoam peanuts put out in cardboard boxes) will be tagged and not picked up. Trash and recycling must be separated for pickup.
12. **All cardboard must be broken down, bundled, and tied;** cardboard with wax coating is not recyclable and should be placed with regular trash.

13. Shredded paper is now considered recycling and will not be picked up as trash. Please do not place shredded paper in plastic bags.
14. DO NOT PUT TRASH FROM STORES OR APARTMENTS IN THE BOROUGH LITTER RECEPTACLES.
15. Trash that is put out in bags must be placed in the property location and not thrown, which could cause the bag to open or tear.

Haddonfield is a leader in recycling through the cooperation of our residents and businesses. Recycling is mandated by law and enforcement guidelines have been established. The items will be collected each week on the regular trash day according to the schedule.

Maps delineating the area receiving collection each day are available in Room 101 at the Borough Hall. Questions regarding trash collection for a particular location can be answered by calling 856-429-0183 (DPW).

Holidays: trash collection may be postponed and rescheduled for the next feasible day. Updated schedules can be found online at www.haddonfieldnj.org.

Chapter 199-21: Use of Streets

C. Other objects such as trash receptacles, storage containers, recyclable containers, construction materials, demolition materials, tools, equipment, non-registered vehicles, landscape materials, toys, shrubs, branches, vegetation, etc., and other such objects are prohibited at any time from being placed in a street or public thoroughfare utilized by motor vehicles.

A section has been added to the Public Works page on the Borough website, www.haddonfieldnj.org, where you can report issues with your trash and recycling pick-up. For immediate issues, please report problems with either trash or recycling pick-up directly to Public Works at 429-0183 x0 (recycling and vegetative waste) or Casworth at 856-848-3505 for trash issues.

The Borough requests your cooperation and compliance with these rules and regulations as they will be enforced. Repeat offenders will received a complaint signed in municipal court. Under the law, the judge can issue fines for these violations.
