



Did you know...?

- Haddon Fire Company is the 2nd oldest **volunteer** fire company in the United States, established in 1764; at the time, each member was required to furnish two leather buckets and an axe.
- Today, our membership consists of men and women who are your **neighbors**. We represent a wide variety of careers such as finance, law enforcement, teaching and more. We participate in other town organizations such as the Rotary Club, The Haddonfield Historic Society and coach Youth Sports.
- Our operating budget is funded by the donations we receive during our annual Fund Drive.
- The Borough of Haddonfield has neither a paid fire department nor levies a fire tax.
- The cost to fully outfit a firefighter with proper Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) is \$6,000.
- Each year our members respond to over 500 emergency calls. Our members respond 24 hours a day, 7 days a week including weekends and holidays. Leaving our families to help yours.
- Our training is a combination of in-station and partnering with various Fire Academies. Training is conducted every Thursday night, on a wide variety of topics to keep our skills fresh.
- Yearly man hours devoted to emergency response and training reaches 11,000 hours.
- Haddon Fire Co #1 and the Haddonfield Ambulance Association currently offer CPR including AED certification classes to the public.
