

Did you know...?

- Haddonfield Ambulance Association was established in 1938; prior to that time,
 Haddonfield Police were responsible for operating the ambulance.
- Today, Haddonfield Ambulance Association maintains two ambulances one as the primary service provider and a second ambulance as a reserve ambulance that also functions on as needed basis for special events. The ambulance service provides emergency services 24 hours a day 7 days a week 365 days a year.
- Our operating budget is funded by the donations we receive during our annual Fund Drive.
- The Borough of Haddonfield has neither a paid fire department nor levies a fire tax.
- Our crews respond to over 1000 emergency calls. Our crews respond 24 hours a day, 7 days a week including weekends and holidays.
- Our crews are trained to the state mandated requirements. Training is a combination of in-station and partnering with Virtua Hospital. Training is conducted regularly throughout the year, on a wide variety of topics to keep our skills fresh.
