Dear Resident,

Over the past six months the Borough hired two contractors to perform extensive work on Colonial Ave and one block of Lake Street. This included a new water main, new water services, new sewer laterals, new curb, new driveway aprons, a significant amount of new sidewalks, handicapped ramps and finally a newly paved roadway. In short, the cost of this project was approximately \$707,500. Additionally, at no cost to the Borough, PSE & G installed a new gas main and all new services. This project provided a significant amount of new infrastructure.

On behalf of the Commissioners I would like to state that we are aware that this has been a long and arduous process. We wanted to express our gratitude for the patience that you have shown while you have endured difficult circumstances. We hope that the long term end result has been worth the short-term trouble construction work always causes.

There may be punch list items which have not been completed at this time. I would urge that if you are aware of any problems created by the various contractors that you reach out to either Steve Fini (795-9596) or Charles Chelotti (795-9595), both of whom are employees of Remington and Vernick, the Borough Engineer firm.
