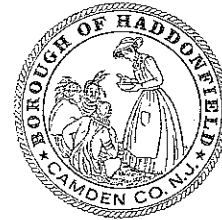

To: Properties abutting Chestnut Street (from East Park Ave to Reillywood Ave)

Re: Planned Paving and Concrete Project

The Borough Commissioners have authorized the complete reconstruction of Chestnut Street. The project will also include installation of new concrete curbing, new concrete driveway aprons, and some sidewalk replacement or installation where necessary based on the judgment of the Borough Engineer. The final element will be the installation of new handicap ramps at all intersections.

Paramount Enterprises Inc of Cherry Hill, NJ will do the road work. The contractor advised us today that he will begin the job as early as September 4, unless there are weather delays. You should have received a notice today from the contractor indicating that he would begin work.

Chestnut Street will be closed to local traffic only during the construction period. During the normal workday, starting after 7:00 a.m., there will be some impact on parking and traffic in the areas where concrete work is being done. We ask that when your side of the street is under concrete construction that you park of the roadway on the opposite side from your home or on the closest side street. While the actual road reconstruction work is in progress no traffic will be permitted during the day. The road will be accessible in the evenings. We would request that all residents park on the closest side street. The Police Department is aware of this situation and will relax enforcement of the overnight parking regulations where appropriate. If you have any concern, please call 784-9161 for overnight parking permission.

Paramount plans to start with the concrete work on the west side of Chestnut beginning at East Park Ave. Work will commence down one side of the street to the end of that block. Work will then switch over to the other side until the block is complete. The contractor will then begin work on the next block and proceed in the same fashion for the next two blocks. Once the concrete work is completed the contractor will mill the entire three block area and begin the reconstruction portion of the project.

Your patience and understanding during this sometimes-messy process will be appreciated. This type of road work is intended to have the least impact possible. The end result for the long term, however, should be worth the short-term trouble construction work always causes.


