

## ADDENDUM 4-21-10

The following items are clarifications to section 5.4 Containers, of the Solid Waste and Recycling Materials Collection Service bid specification.

1. The number of items picked up at each household is six (6) – 32 gallon containers or materials equivalent to that amount. There is no limit for recycling materials, metal goods or vegetative waste.
2. All residents, including those located in the Borough of Tavistock that are located on Tavistock Lane have trash and recycling picked up on the current Monday schedule. Recycling is also picked up from the Tavistock Country Club on the Monday route. No trash is picked up at the Tavistock Country Club.
3. Wedgewood Swim Club has daily pick-up of cans from mid-April through the end of September.
4. All white goods shall be brought back to the Public Works yard and placed in a designated area. The Borough of Haddonfield will be responsible for disposal.
5. All E-waste shall be treated as white good and be brought back to the Public Works yard and placed in a designated area. The Borough of Haddonfield will be responsible for disposal.
6. The Borough's 1.5 cy dumpsters do not need to be replaced by the contractor unless they do not work with the contractor's equipment. However, should a container be damaged it must be replaced at the cost of the contractor. Additionally the contractor will replace any containers that are in need of replacement during the term of the contract, those replaced containers will be the property of the contractor.
7. Additionally there are public cans dispersed throughout the town that must be collected as part of this contract. There are 38 trash cans and 11 recycling cans. Their location and collection schedule is attached to this addendum.
