AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF HADDONFIELD, COUNTY OF CAMDEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, VARIOUS CHAPTERS TO CHANGE THE FEES CHARGED

BE IT ORDAINED BY the Board of Commissioners of the Borough of Haddonfield, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION I:

- 1. Chapter 107, entitled Fees, Article I – Copies of Records, Section 107-3, entitled Fees for Copies shall be amended as follows:

§107-3(D.) Vital Statistics.

- (1) Certified copy of marriage certificates, birth certificates, death certificates and domestic partnership agreements and civil unions: [~~\$5~~]
[a] First copy: \$10
[b] All copies thereafter: \$5

- 2. Chapter 178, entitled Sales, Special, Article II – Garage Sales, Section 107-8, entitled Fees and late charges shall be amended as follows:

§178-8(A.) The fee(s) to be paid for a license to be issued hereunder shall be as follows: [~~\$2~~] **\$5** when the license is applied for and obtained prior to the date of the sale as required by §178-7 of this article.

- 3. Chapter 135, entitled Land Development, Article XIII – Fees, Section 135-115 entitled Development application fees shall be amended as follows:

§135-115 Development application fees.

(c) Tier II application	[\$125] \$175	20	14 days before Historic Preservation Commissioner meeting or 28 days before Planning Board meeting, whichever date is earlier

- 4. Chapter 135, entitled Land Development, Article XIV – Zoning Officer shall be amended to include the following:

§135-125.1 Zoning Permit Fees

Every application for zoning shall be accompanied by a check payable to the Borough of Haddonfield in the amount of: \$30



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5. Chapter 199, entitled Streets and Sidewalks, Article II – Construction and Repair of Sidewalks and Curbing, Section 199-15 entitled Permit required; fees shall be amended as follows:

§199-15. Permit required; fees.

Prior to performing any work to install, replace or repair any sidewalk, curb or driveway apron within the public right-of-way in the Borough of Haddonfield, a permit must be obtained from the Borough Clerk of the Borough of Haddonfield. A fee shall be paid for said permit as follows:

- A. For the first 50 square feet of sidewalk adjacent to a lot, the fee shall be [~~\$2~~] **\$25** and \$1 for every 50 square feet or portion thereafter.
- B. For the first 50 linear feet of curb adjacent to a lot, the fee shall be [~~\$2~~] **\$25** and \$1 for every 50 linear feet or portion thereafter.
- C. For every driveway apron connecting to a legal driveway or parking area on a lot, the fee shall be [~~\$2~~] **\$25**.
- D. In addition to the normal charges above, a late charge of [~~\$5~~] **\$10** must be paid when a permit is obtained after work has commenced but prior to any written notice by a Borough representative either for failure to obtain the required permit or requiring repair or for repair or replacement as provided for in this article.
- E. In addition to the normal charges above, a late charge of [~~\$10~~] **\$20** must be paid when a permit is obtained after work has commenced following any written notice by a Borough representative either for failure to obtain the required permit or requiring repair or for repair or replacement as provided for in this article.
- F. Payment of a late charge per Subsections D and E above does not mean the applicant is not in violation of the requirements of this article.

SECTION III:

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this amending ordinance be and they are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies only.

SECTION IV:

If any section or provision of this ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid by any court, the remaining sections and provisions shall, notwithstanding such holding, remain and be in full force and effect.

SECTION V:

This ordinance shall be in effect upon passage and publication according to law.
