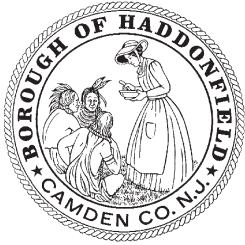


Borough of Haddonfield HOW TO RECYCLE



Please post prominently in your kitchen, mud room, or other convenient location.

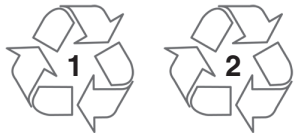
And remember ...

REDUCE! REUSE! RECYCLE!

ALUMINUM, GLASS, PLASTIC, TIN CONTAINERS RECYCLE: RED BIN

RECYCLE:

- ✓ Aluminum cans
- ✓ Tin cans
- ✓ Glass bottles, jars
- ✓ Plastic bottles with "1" or "2" inside the Recycle symbol on label or side/bottom of bottle:



1 = water and soda bottles, medicine containers, etc.;
2 = milk, laundry, shampoo bottles, etc.

Note! Rinse bottles and cans until clean. Leave labels in place. Put lids, caps, and spray nozzles in trash.

PUT IN TRASH:

- ✗ Aerosol cans
- ✗ Glass or plastic bottles that contained motor oil, bug spray, weed killer, etc.
- ✗ Glass dishes, cups
- ✗ Light bulbs
- ✗ Mirrors
- ✗ Plastic bottles with no number, or with a "3" or higher inside the Recycle symbol.
- ✗ Plastic bottle caps
- ✗ Spray nozzles
- ✗ Styrofoam filler material, containers, packaging
- ✗ Tin can lids
- ✗ Window glass

RECYCLING saves money, keeps taxes down. And it's the law.

VEGETATIVE WASTE RECYCLE: GREEN BIN

- ✓ Grass clippings, leaves, small branches. Alternative 1: Place in recyclable paper bag. Alternative 2: Place in regular trash can with yellow sticker (obtainable at Borough Hall).

Note! The Borough will not pick up plastic bags containing grass clippings, leaves, etc.

PAPER, THIN CARDBOARD, CORRUGATED CARDBOARD RECYCLE: BLUE BIN

RECYCLE:

- ✓ Beverage cartons
- ✓ Catalogs
- ✓ Cereal boxes
Remove liner
- ✓ Corrugated board
Tie in bundles and place next to Blue Bin
- ✓ Cookie boxes
- ✓ Envelopes
inc. window envelopes
- ✓ File folders
- ✓ Home office paper
- ✓ "Junk" mail
- ✓ Magazines
- ✓ Newspapers
- ✓ Paper bags
- ✓ Paperback books
Or donate to Library, Aug & early Sep only
- ✓ Phone books
- ✓ Pizza boxes
Remove food first!
- ✓ Soda cartons
- ✓ Wrapping paper
- ✓ Window envelopes

PUT IN TRASH:

- ✗ Food-stained paper, bags, boxes
- ✗ Hardcover books
Or donate to Library, Aug & early Sep only
- ✗ Juice cartons
- ✗ Milk cartons
- ✗ Padded mailing envelopes and bags
- ✗ Paper cups, napkins, plates, towels
- ✗ Plastic-coated (Tyvek®) envelopes
- ✗ Tissues

Need more bins?
Colored recycling bins may be purchased at the Public Works facility (Centre Street opposite Scout Field) on weekdays from 8am to 4pm. \$10 per bin.
