

Available to eligible senior citizens through Camden County are various programs to assist with home maintenance issues. Please call 856-663-1717 or 2255 for information on these programs and more.

Senior Safe Home Program

Provided through the Union Organization for Social Services (UOSS)

This program provides home maintenance and repair to help maintain the health and safety of Camden County senior homeowners. UOSS employs union craft workers who repair senior's homes at no cost to the owners. The Camden County Division of Senior Services and the William G. Rohrer Foundation make this program possible.

Mr. Fix-It Program

Provided through the Camden County Division of Senior Services

This program provides minor carpentry, electrical, plumbing, concrete, window chains & pane replacement and locks. It does not provide yard work, painting, cleaning of gutters or house cleaning.

Camden County Community Development Program

Provided through Camden County

This program provides no-interest loans for qualified homeowners to make necessary home improvements to their properties. Funding to agencies who provide services to homeless individuals and families. Provides affordable housing by rehabilitating owner occupied housing, first-time home buyers' activities, and consortium housing activities with Cherry Hill and Gloucester Township.
