Mosquito Control is everyone's responsibility; please dump all standing water once each week to prevent mosquitoes from developing on your property. In compliance with section 9.10 & 9.15 of the New Jersey Pesticide Control Code (N.J.A.C. Title 7, Chapter 30) The Camden County Mosquito Extermination Commission (CCMEC) may be applying pesticides for the control of adult mosquito populations on an area-wide basis, as needed, throughout Camden County during the period of May 14 through November 20, 2009.

The pesticides used will be those recommended by the New Jersey Agricultural Experiment Station (NJAES) for the control of adult mosquitoes which include: Malathion (Fyfanon ULV®), Resmethrin & Piperonyl Butoxide (Scourge®) or Atrapa®. Products will be applied from the ground by truck or handheld equipment using Ultra Low Volume techniques. An approved larvicide may be applied by aircraft when necessary. All applications will be according to product labeling.

Upon request the CCMEC shall provide a resident with notification at least 12 hours prior to the application, except for Quarantine and Disease Vector Control only, when conditions necessitate pesticide applications sooner than that time.
