AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF HADDONFIELD, COUNTY OF CAMDEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, CHAPTERS 232 ENTITLED VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC TO REMOVE PARKING METERS ON STILES AVENUE

BE IT ORDAINED BY the Board of Commissioners of the Borough of Haddonfield, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION I:

1. Chapter 232, entitled Vehicles and Traffic, Article IV – Parking, Section 232-32, entitled Metered Parking is hereby amended to remove the following location as metered parking:

§232-32. Metered parking.

A. Parking meters shall be placed in locations designated by the Commissioners of the Borough of Haddonfield on the following streets in Haddonfield:

Name of Street	Sides	Location
Stiles Avenue	North	Tanner Street to westerly terminus

2. Chapter 232, entitled Vehicles and Traffic, Article IV – Parking, Section 232-37, entitled Parking Prohibited at All Times on Certain Streets is hereby amended to include the following location:

§232-27. Parking prohibited at all times on certain streets.

No person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any of the streets or parts thereof described below:

Name of Street	Sides	Location
Stiles Avenue	North	Tanner Street to westerly terminus

SECTION III:

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this amending ordinance be and they are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies only.

SECTION IV:

If any section or provision of this ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid by any court, the remaining sections and provisions shall, notwithstanding such holding, remain and be in full force and effect.

SECTION V:

This ordinance shall be in effect upon passage and publication according to law.
