AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF HADDONFIELD, COUNTY OF CAMDEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, CHAPTER 135, ENTITLED LAND DEVELOPMENT, TO ALLOW FOR CHANGES APPOINTMENT TERMS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Borough of Haddonfield, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION I

1. Chapter 135 of the codified ordinances of the Borough of Haddonfield, entitled Land Development, Article XII entitled Establishment of Planning Board is hereby amended as follows:

§135-110 Establishment of Planning Board.

- D. Terms of Class IV regular members first appointed pursuant to this chapter shall be so determined that to the greatest practicable extent the expiration of such term shall be evenly distributed over the first four years after their appointment, provided that the initial term shall not exceed four years. Thereafter the term of each Class IV regular member shall be four years. All terms shall run from **June 1** ~~January 1~~ of the year in which the appointment is made.
- E. The terms of the Class IV alternate members shall be two years, except that the terms of the alternate members shall be such that the term of not more than one alternate member shall expire **in** any one year; provided, however, that in no instance shall the terms of the alternate members first appointed exceed two years. All terms shall run from **June 1** ~~January 1~~ of the year in which the appointment was made.

SECTION II

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this amending ordinance shall be and they are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies only.

SECTION III

If any section or provision of this ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid by any court, the remaining sections and provisions shall, notwithstanding such holding, remain and be in full force and effect.

SECTION IV

This ordinance shall be in effect upon passage and publication according to law.
